

Q203 Global Medical Humanities

Overall programme structure(s) and requirements, levels and modules

You must take modules to a value of 120 credits. Some of these credits will be from compulsory modules, and some will be from optional modules within your subject area which you can choose each year. To be eligible for the award of your degree you must have passed a minimum of 105 credits, including 90 credits at level 6.

Year 1 – Level 6

You must take the following **105 credits**:

- 15 credits GMH6063 Global Medical Humanities: The Human in Medicine (compulsory module)
- 30 credits GMH6200 Global Medical Humanities Research Project (compulsory module)
- 15 credits GMH6060 Language and Health Communication (compulsory module)
- 15 credits GMH6064 Cinema and Disability (compulsory module)
- 15 credits GMH6065 Madness, Past and Present (compulsory module)
- 15 credits GMH6066 Medicine and Ethics in Global Literature (compulsory module)

You will choose the remaining **15 credits** from all optional modules offered in SLLF at **level 6**. Registration on optional is subject to space available on modules, and with the guidance of your advisor. You must also ensure that the module fits into your timetable.

Requirements for award

To be eligible for award of your degree you must have passed a minimum of 105 credits, including 90 credits at level 6.
