As a new first year student of Film Studies your 120 credits of modules are core/compulsory, meaning you do not have any optional module choices to make.

All students must take 120 credits (including your core/compulsory modules), over two semesters (Semester A: September – December and Semester B: January – April).

- FLM4204 US Cinema: Key Concepts (30 credits, Full Year, Level 4).
- FLM4201 Scriptwriting: Creativity and Technique (30 credits, Semester A, Level 4).
- FLM4203 Production Skills (30 credits, Semester B, Level 4).
